Entries must be received by **6 pm CDT Wednesday, September 11** after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$20 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express & certified deliveries must include a signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. Entries received without signature release will be refused.

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. Confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed after closing. If you want a hard copy confirmation mailed, please note this on your entry.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial.

Emailed entries: Entries may be emailed to sjceaster@gmail.com. Both the front & back of each entry form must be included, filled out completely and signed or the entry will not be accepted. Payment can be made via PayPal at OKCBC2023@gmail.com. Please use Friends & Family on PayPal so that we may avoid extra fees. Entry Errors: Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. Il entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

Move ups to Best of Breed or Open/Master Jr Show classes: Dogs which, according to the owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for this show may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class. Similarly, an entrant in a Novice Junior Showmanship can be transferred to Open if the junior has earned a third 1st place, and an Open entry can be moved to master's if the junior has earned a tenth first place, after this show's closing date. Each of these transfer requests must be made and accepted by, the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of any regular confirmation judging for the show.

First place in each 6-9 and 9-12 class will compete for Best Puppy. If a puppy is Best of Breed or Best of Winners, that puppy will automatically win Best Puppy.

NOHS (All OKC Shows)

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned, co-owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dogs are Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

* Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this competition. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay. or received payment for handling a dog.

SWEEPSTAKES (Friday only)

Sweepstakes is open to all Bulldogs who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. Champions of record are NOT eligible. Professional handlers may show their own Bulldogs ONLY. All Bulldogs entered in Sweepstakes MUST ALSO be entered in a regular class on the day of the Sweepstakes. Entries must be made on the same entry form as the regular classes, in the space for "Additional Classes."

DISTRIBUTION OF SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

35% of total entry fees are retained by the club for expenses. The remaining 65% is divided as follows:

1st Prize in each class: 40% of class entry	2nd Prize in each class: 30% of class entry
3rd Prize in each class: 20% of class entry	4th Prize in each class: 10% of class entry

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

<u>Novice class</u>: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

<u>Open class</u>: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Junior Showmanship Novice class at a licensed or member show.

<u>Master class</u>: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front **and** back of the entry form. Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

Show & Show Site Rules

- All Bulldogs will be judged on a ramp
- No dogs are to be left in building overnight. Dogs must only be exercised in the designated out-door exercise area
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free from internal and external parasites, communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccines
- Grooming and crate set-up areas will be designated. Only small battery-operated crate fans are allowed. There will be no reserved grooming at the show, but plenty of space will be available
- Admission to show is free. Exhibitors are encouraged to bring own chairs
- Show room will have a concrete floor
- Smoking is prohibited inside the building
- Alcoholic beverages may not be consumed, served or sold on premises. Local authorities may check for violations of this policy, and if found, the Show will be ended!
- Parents and Guardians must always keep children under control on the show grounds! The welfare of an exhibitor's child in the sole responsibility of the exhibitor.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Bulldogs are expected to be judged on a ramp. No dogs or puppies are to be sold at the show site.

Show Secretary-Stevie Easter

1.Entries must be submitted on an American Kennel Club (AKC) Official Entry Form or exact copy (both front & back) and must be signed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks. The Club and/or its Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or owner's Agent entering a dog or a class for which the dog is not eligible to compete. Conditional entries are not accepted.

2.Make checks payable to Bulldog Club of Oklahoma City. No cash will be accepted. ENTRIES CLOSE 6PM CST, WEDNESDAY, SEPT 11, 2024 at the Show Secretary's address. Stevie Easter

3.Online entries will only be accepted by sending a completed Entry Form to the Show Secretary by email, and paying the appropriate fees using PayPal (Friends and Family) to <u>OKCBC2023@gmail.com</u>.

4.Exhibitors are advised to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available from the Show Secretary or may be obtained from the AKC.

5. A recording fee of 50 cents and an Event Service Fee of \$3,00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule, Chapter 14, Sec. 2).

6. Judging programs will be emailed to the email address given on the entry blank.

7. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbance, natural disaster, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.

8. There will be a \$35 fee for all checks returned for insufficient funds. All checks must be drawn in US Funds.

9. A dog which, according to its owners' records, has completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose Championship is unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation Judging at the show.

10. Trophies and cash prizes will be awarded in the judging rings. In the event of a discrepancy from the published prize list, the Show Secretary should be advised at once. Trophies not claimed on the day of show are forfeited.

11. Fees must be submitted with checks drawn on U.S. accounts, in U.S. funds.

12. Entry fee shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of Show Committee or because it has been entered incorrectly.

13. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of the entry fee will be made.
